

BAFFLE BLANKET 3120-200

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Replaces MPNs: 3120-200

Before Installing

- **ALWAYS** unplug the unit before beginning any work
 - Allow the unit to cool completely if recently used
 - Work in a well-lit area with proper tools
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Installation Steps

1. Disconnect Power

- Ensure the unit is completely cooled down and drained of power.
- Unplug the stove from the powersource.

2. Access the Unit

- Open the main door to the unit. The baffle blanket will be hanging on the baffle boards on the inside of the stove firebox, typically laying on top of the reburn tubes in the top of the unit.
- On some models you may need to remove the top casting to gain access to this area.

3. Remove Old Baffle

- Carefully pull the baffle blanket off the baffle boards and out of the unit. Some models may not require removal of any other parts to do this.
- If the blanket needs to be accessed by removing the top casting or a retaining bracket, proceed to remove said parts through the proper procedures your unit calls for in your owner's manual. Some units may

also require you to move or remove some of the reburn tubes to better access the blanket.

- It is recommended to replace the blanket when replacing the baffle, especially if the blanket looks frayed and damaged.

4. Install New Baffle

- Reposition the new blanket in place on the baffle boards.
- Sometimes it helps if you fold the blanket in half, slide it into position and then unfold it once in place for easier installation.

5. Connect Power

- Reinstall any reburn tubes removed in Step 3
- Reinstall top casting and any retainers if removed in Step 2.
- Close the main door of the stove. Ensure the door is sealed when closed.
- Plug the stove's power cord into the power source.
- Your new baffle blanket is installed and ready to use.

Post-Installation Check

- Verify all connections are secure
- Test the seal of the door to ensure proper fitment. The door should be sealed tightly when both the handle is secured and the gasket is at proper thickness.
- Check the baffles and blankets for damage before final installation.
