Convection Blower

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Before Installing

- **ALWAYS** unplug the unit before beginning any work
 - Allow the unit to cool completely if recently used
 - Work in a well-lit area with proper tools
-

Installation Steps

1. Power Disconnection

Unplug the unit from the power source.

2. Access the Unit

- Remove the wiring access panel from the stove to locate and access the blower in the mechanical area inside the mechanical area.
- The access panel should be located toward the rear side of the stove (refer to your stove's owner's manual for the approximate location of the convection fan).

3. Disconnect Fan Wiring

Disconnect the fan wiring connector from the wiring harness.

4. Remove Old Fan

- Remove the mounting screws securing the blower in place.
- Pull the fan assembly away from the motor area.

5. Install the New Fan

- Insert and position the new blower onto the convection assembly in the same orientation as the old blower.
- Secure the fan with the previously removed mounting screws.

6. Connect Fan Wiring

Connect the wiring connector from the new fan to the wiring harness.

7. Final Assembly

Reinstall the wiring access panel onto the hopper.

8. Power Connection

Connect the grill to the power source with the power cord.

Post-Installation Check

- Verify all connections are secure
 - Test blower operation before closing panels
 - Check for any unusual noises or vibrations
