

DRIP TRAY LINER BAC410

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Replaces MPNs: PG36-3, GMG-4104, P-4104, BAC410

Before Installing

- **ALWAYS** unplug the unit before beginning any work
 - Allow the unit to cool completely if recently used
 - Work in a well-lit area with proper tools
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Installation Steps

1. Disconnect Power

- Ensure the unit is completely cooled down and drained of power.
- Unplug the grill from the power source.

2. Access the Unit

- Open the main grill lid.
- Locate the drip tray in the grill. The drip tray is typically mounted inside the burn area under the grill grates.
- Remove the grill grates from the grill's cooking area.
 - In some models, you may need to also remove the broiler pieces to access the drip tray.

3. Remove Old Drip Tray Liner

- Lift the old drip tray liner out from the grill barrel. The drip tray liner would typically sit on the drip tray.
- It would be recommended to clean the inside of the grill with a grill degreaser and cleaner at this time.

5. Install New Drip Tray Liner

- Insert the new drip tray liner onto the surface of the drip tray, ensure the tray sits flush and even on the mounting brackets.
- The drip tray liner must be oriented in the same direction as the old drip tray liner to allow the drip tray to stay clean longer and provide optimal drainage of grease.

6.. Connect Power

- Install the removed cooking grates and broiler pieces to the grill.
- Close the main grill lid.
- Plug the grill's power cord into the power source.
- Your new drip tray is installed and ready to use.

Post-Installation Check

- Verify the drip sits flush inside the grill before final assembly
- Ensure the drip tray drains into the drip bucket sufficiently.
- Be careful not to touch the grill while testing or operating, allow the unit to cool completely before making any adjustments.
