

OVERHEAT SENSOR CB-OVERHEATWIRE

INSTALL INSTRUCTIONS

Replaces MPNs: CB92CSensor, 92C, CB-Sensor-92C

Before Installing

- **ALWAYS** unplug the unit before beginning any work
 - Allow the unit to cool completely if recently used
 - Work in a well-lit area with proper tools
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Installation Steps

1. Disconnect Power

- Ensure the unit is completely cooled down and drained of power.
- Unplug the stove from the powersource.

2. Access the Unit

- Remove the screws securing the access panel to the stove closest to the sensor. The Room Temperature sensor would typically be inserted into a port in proximity to the exhaust fan.
- Carefully remove the access panel and set it aside.

3. Disconnect & Remove Old Sensor

- Before disconnecting anything, take clear photos of all wiring connections from multiple angles. This is the single best way to avoid mistakes during reassembly.
- Unplug the wiring lead for the old sensor from the control board.
 - **Note:** Always pull on the connector body, never on the wires themselves, pulling on wires can damage the connector or break the crimp.

4. Remove Old Sensor

With a pair of pliers, carefully pull the sensor out of the housing sleeve.

5. Install New Sensor

- Apply some high-temperature silicone to the sides of the metal cylinder end of the sensor.
- Slide the new sensor into the housing sleeve.

6. Connect Wiring

- Plug the wiring lead for the new sensor into the control board
- Ensure the connector is fully seated, you should feel or hear it click into place. A loose connection is the most common cause of post-installation issues.

7. Power Connection

- Secure the removed access panel with screws removed in Step 2
- Plug the stove into the power source.
- Your new Room Temperature sensor is ready to use

Post-Installation Check

- Verify all connections are secure
- Test sensor operation before closing panels
- Check for any unusual noises or vibrations
