Convection Blower

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Before Installing

- **ALWAYS** unplug the unit before beginning any work
 - Allow the unit to cool completely if recently used
 - Work in a well-lit area with proper tools
-

Installation Steps

1. Power Disconnection

Unplug your stove from the power.

2. Access the unit

Remove the rear access panel on the unit to access the convection blower.

3. Disconnect Blower Wiring

Unplug the blower wiring connectors from the wiring harness.

Tip: you can take a photo of the wires to note the color coding of the wires and connections before removal.

4. Remove Old Fan

- Remove the mounting screws that hold the combustion fan.
- Pull the old blower and gasket out from the stove mechanical cabinet.

5. Install New Fan

- Fasten the new blower and gasket into the stove in the same orientation as the old blower.

- A new gasket is not included with the blower, it is recommended to acquire a new gasket before installation in case the old gasket is worn down or damaged.

6. Connect Blower Wiring

Plug the fan wiring connectors back into the controller in the same connections as the original blower.

7. Final Assembly

Install the wiring access panel removed prior.

8. Power Connection

Plug in the stove to test.

Post-Installation Check

- Verify all connections are secure
- Test blower operation before closing panels
- Check for any unusual noises or vibrations
