

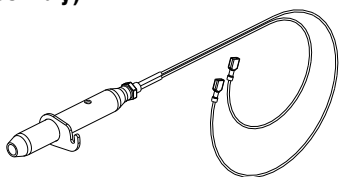
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR FASTFIRE® IGNITERS FOR USE WITH MODEL MONTAGE™ 32FS PELLET STOVES

KIT CONTENTS (for igniter assembly)

- 1 ea. Igniter Assembly
- 1 ea. Instruction Sheet

TOOLS REQUIRED

- 5/32" Allen Wrench
- 1/4" Nut Driver or Wrench

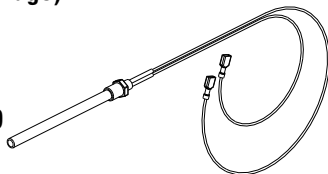


KIT CONTENTS (for igniter cartridge)

- 1 ea. Igniter Cartridge
- 1 ea. Instruction Sheet

ADDITIONAL TOOLS REQUIRED

- 5/8" Wrench
- Anti-Seize Lubricant

TURN OFF THE STOVE AND ALLOW IT TO COMPLETELY COOL BEFORE PROCEEDING.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1. UNPLUG STOVE.

Step 2. Using a 1/4" nut driver or wrench, loosen the four screws holding the back cover on and remove it through keyhole slots.

Step 3. From the back of the stove, locate the igniter wires coming from the area near the back of the firebox and unplug them from the main harness.

Step 4. Open front door and remove UltraGrate™ and ash pan.

Step 5. Using a 5/32" allen wrench, loosen the screw inside of UltraGrate cradle on firebox back that holds igniter in place (see **Figure 1**). It does not need to be completely removed.

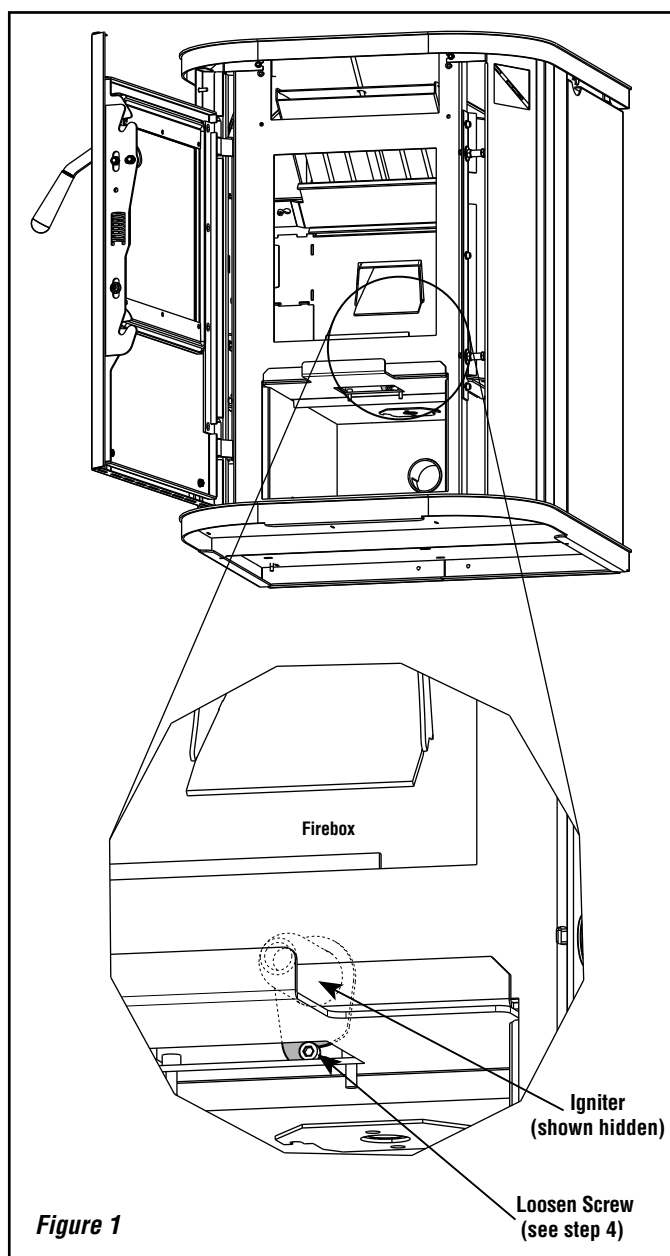
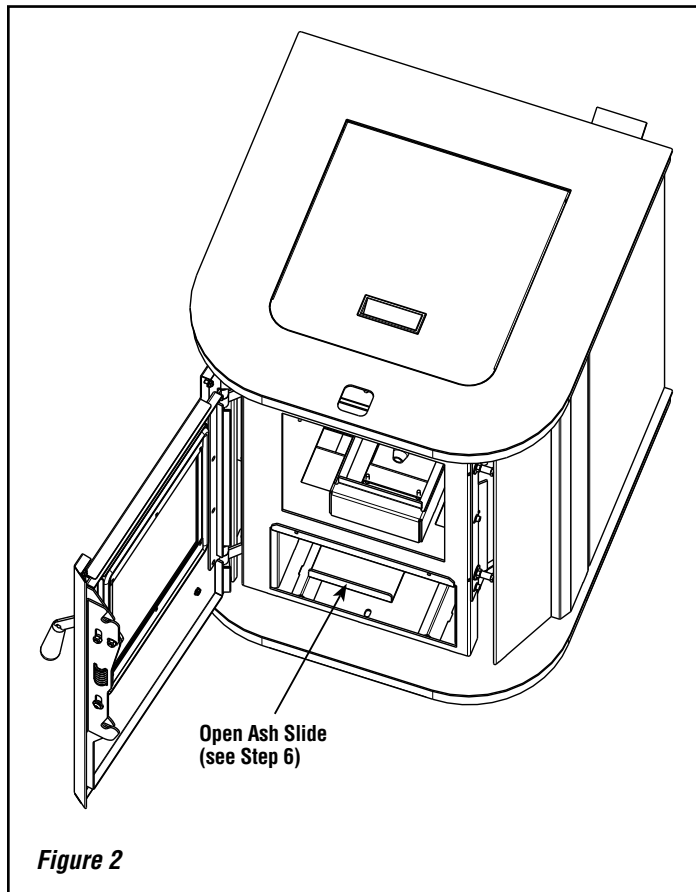
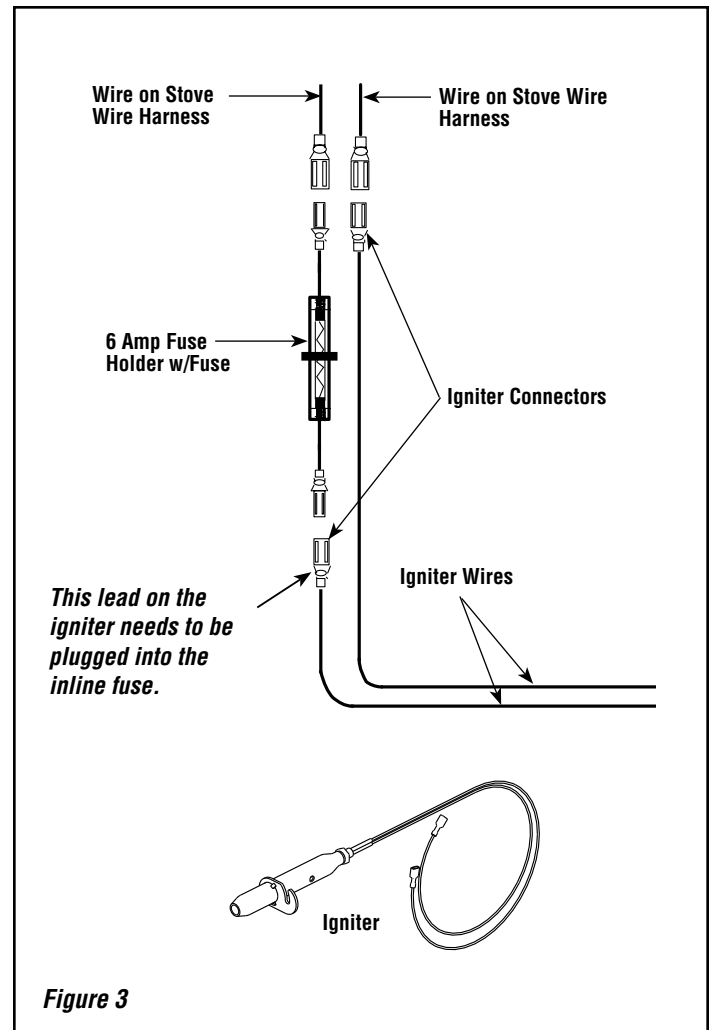

- Step 6.** Open ash slide plate about 1-3/4" to increase the opening inside the firebox underneath the UltraGrate™. See **Figure 2**.
- Step 7.** Rotate igniter assembly clockwise until mounting flange clears screw head.
- Step 8.** Remove igniter assembly through the opening in the bottom of the firebox and out the ash pan opening.
- Step 9.** Install the replacement igniter by reversing steps 4 through 7. Connect the wires as shown in **Figure 3**.



NOTE: When routing wires, ensure they are not in contact with any of the components in the rear of the stove (i.e. blowers, auger motor, etc.).
